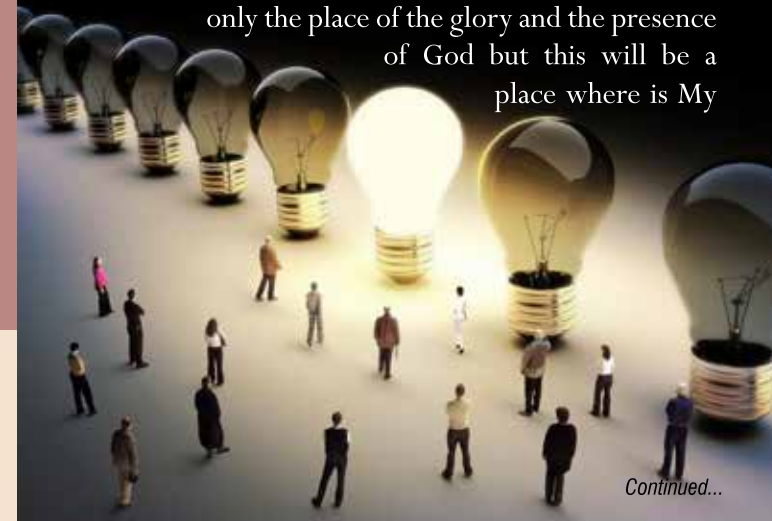

One of our many favourite verses is Proverbs 3:5 “Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not rely on your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths”. We often quote it so easily and yet find a disconnect in practical application, in reality. Why is it? Is there an element, a something that we are missing out on?

Then that old time favourite song springs to heart to help: “Trust and obey, for there is no other way, to be happy in Jesus but to trust and obey”. Ah, yes. Trust and obey. If we say we trust in the Lord, we also need to obey Him; otherwise trust without obedience is just lip service.

Many of us struggle with obeying God. King Saul had that real struggle and made excuses to not obey God. In 1 Samuel 15, Saul utterly destroyed the following commands the life of the sheep. From this Saul lost his own kingdom. Samuel as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.” (1 Sam 15:22).



When Jesus asked the disabled man who had been an invalid for 38 years at the pool in Bethesda, “Do you want to be well? Rise, take up your mat and walk”, the man only needed at that moment to obey to get his miracle. His trust in Jesus was followed by obedience and he got his healing (John 5:1-8).

Many of us do not admit it but we find it easier to give sacrifices to God than to obey God. We hope, like King Saul, that our sacrifices will make up for our disobedience; that God will overlook our not obeying Him through the aroma of our sacrifices. Not so! church of God. May we obey God fully instead of thinking that there are other alternatives to obedience! Perhaps we should from now on read Proverbs 3:5 as “Trust in (and obey) the Lord with all your heart; do not rely on your own understanding. In all your ways, acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths”. It will make the whole world of difference to you.
