**Ps Jason:** What is the ONE important thing we need to focus to make us different? ONE man, ONE person can make a difference. Doing the ONE thing that makes a difference. Stop for God and stop for ONE. You

are doing the ONE thing that make a difference. Stop for one today to give an encouraging word. Say something positive. There are many things but one thing that will make a difference. Everyday we do so many things. Short of time. Not enough time. We lose focus. So many distractions. So many things pressing on us. Demands from our work, bosses, clients, school works, house chores. What is the one most important thing of the day that I should do that will make me someone that makes a difference. I do many things but still not make a difference. Is it an important thing? Is it an urgent thing? The urgent thing may not be an important thing.

Call someone. Visit someone. Send an encouraging message to someone. Apologize to someone. Read the Word. Spend time in prayer. Don't rush away from His presence. When you read the Scriptures, what is the one thing that stands out, that convicts you, encourages you, inspires you; that stirs your spirit within. What is the one thing that God is speaking to you? That's the one thing that makes the difference. That's the one thing you focus on. For the one thing, you need to hear from God. That's why you need to read the word of God, hear from the Holy Spirit, from others.

Seek the one thing that makes a difference. The one thing you desire will be the thing that will cause you to act and motivate you to do. Ps 27:4. Focus on the one thing that makes the

difference. Luke 10:38-42. Martha was distracted by many things; Mary has done the one thing that is needful. In the presence of God, don't be distracted by your handphone. Let's not be troubled by many things. Things I can do later, I will do later. Ecc 3:1 there is a time for every purpose under heaven. When it is time to seek God, seek Him. Don't do a lot of things at one time. Because you can't. With so many pressing things, you can't hear from God. What is distracting you today? God is calling you to put aside these things and He will give you rest.

Reach forward to the one thing that makes a difference. Phil 12:13. Don't walk backward, reach forward. Do the one thing that is lacking that will make a difference. In Mark 10, the rich ruler did not do the one thing he lacked and that caused him to be out of the kingdom of God. Make it right, do it, correct it. What is the Holy Spirit prompting you? To the church of Ephesus, Jesus said to do the one thing it lacked. Return to the first love. In our lives, each one of us have something to avoid, to postpone, to pay little attention to it, push it away, and that will affect us. Jesus is returning for a perfect bride so that we can do better than what we are now; we can reach our potential.

There are many things in life, in a day, but only one thing that makes a difference, that matters. What is the one thing that makes the difference; let the Holy Spirit tell you, be sensitive, not to be pressed by things that trouble you. Seek the one thing that makes a difference. Focus on the one thing that makes a difference. Reach forward to the one thing that makes a difference; forgetting the things behind, reaching forward. Do the one thing that is lacking that makes a difference; not thinking about it, not considering about it, not blaming others about it but act upon it. Pursue for the One thing that will make a difference. Work for the One thing that will make a difference. ■

## BIBLE READING FOR MARCH 2017

Our Bible reading for February explores Jesus' 2nd coming and the signposts that He gave to the Church towards this impending cataclysmic event. When He returns, all will be subjected to judgment; judgment seat of Christ where believers will be rewarded according to their works and the great white throne judgment where all will be judged for eternity. Our life here on earth is like a probation period. How we live now will determine how we will live then; in eternity.

In light of this, in the book of Revelation, Jesus assessed, commented and advised the seven churches listed. His assessment, comments, and advice to those churches then are applicable to churches now – that means we can learn from them so that we may receive a good report when He returns and judges.

**Rev 1** Introduction; this book is the Revelation (the revealing/unfolding/making known) of Jesus Christ (which God gave Him) to show His servants – things which must shortly take place. The whole book is about Jesus Christ, the main character, and the Church.

The Seven Churches:

- Rev 2:1-7** Ephesus
- Rev 2:8-11** Smyrna
- Rev 2:12-17** Pergamos
- Rev 2:18-29** Thyatira
- Rev 3:1-6** Sardis
- Rev 3:7-13** Philadelphia
- Rev 3:14-22** Laodicea

**For each of the churches, list out the following:**

- 1) Commendation**
- 2) Criticism/Rebuke**
- 3) Instruction**
- 4) Promise**

As you compile the list above, let it mirror your life and see what you can do to re-set and re-align to His instruction. His promise awaits those who read, hear and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near (Rev 1:3)
