When we think about it, most of us will say that yes, the Holy Spirit has been there right at the beginning of our faith walk with Jesus. More so, the Holy Spirit was emphasized on us because we worship in a Pentecostal church which connects itself as an early offshoot of the Azusa Street Revival. Don't know what this event is about? The **Azusa Street Revival** were the historic Pentecostal revival meetings that took place in Los Angeles, California and is the origin of the Pentecostal movement. It was led by William J. Seymour, an African American preacher. It began with a meeting on April 9, 1906. The revival was characterized by

**ecstatic spiritual experiences accompanied by amazing physical healing miracles, dramatic worship services, speaking in tongues, and inter-racial mingling.**

Today, the revival is considered by historians to be the primary catalyst for the spread of Pentecostalism in the 20th century - a Movement that changed the religious landscape and became the most vibrant force for world evangelization in the 20th century. Azusa Street became the most significant revival of the century in terms of global perspective.

The first generation of believers in Siloam AOG, our earlier name, came to the Lord in the mid-1970s and 1980s through the powerful ministry and outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Many of us

Paul asked the 12 disciples in Ephesus, "Have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed? They replied, "We have not so much as heard that there is a Holy Spirit". Then Paul laid his hands on them and the Holy Spirit came on them; and they spoke with tongues, and prophesied. This is the exciting account in Acts 19:1-7.

Today, there are still many believers like the Ephesians who have not received the Holy Spirit since they first believed in Jesus. They stop at salvation, thinking that's all to it, without knowing or realising that after salvation, there is that separate, identifiable, tangible, real second spiritual experience that the book of Acts clearly speaks of. The final instruction Jesus gave to his disciples was to wait, "Tarry in Jerusalem until you are given power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you so that you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth". And on the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came with the sound of a mighty rushing wind and descended on the 120. Before that, they were cloistered in the upper room, hiding somewhat still fearful and afraid of the Jewish authorities; after they were baptised in the Holy Spirit, boldness came and after Peter's first citywide preaching 3,000 were added. From a small group of 120, the early church suddenly exploded in one day. And daily, more converts were added. Talk about power. Talk about excitement! We indeed need the Holy Spirit in us and with us to do the greater works which Jesus said we will do.

Besides the power and boldness to evangelise, the Holy Spirit brings personal gifts and benefits to the believer. Through speaking in other tongues, the believer is edified and built up in his faith. Paul explains that "Those who speak in a tongue build up themselves" (1 Cor 14:4). Jude adds in verse 20, "Beloved, build yourselves on your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit." Praying in the Holy Spirit means praying in tongues which builds up our faith because in an unknown tongue, we speak to God (1 Cor 14:2) and not to men; and the Holy Spirit intercedes for us (Rom 8:27) according to the will of God and the Spirit helps us in our weakness and prays through tongues in ways which we did not know how to pray as we ought to (Rom 8:26).

Have you received the Holy Spirit since you believed? If you have not, you can receive the Holy Spirit today; like Paul when after he prayed for them, the Holy Spirit will come upon you and you will speak in new tongues; you will experience that second refreshing spiritual experience; you will be edified and built up in your faith as you pray in tongues; you will be speaking to God more and more as you pray in tongues; you will have the Holy Spirit interceding on your behalf according to the will of God. With all these benefits awaiting to bless you, ask your church leader more about the Holy Spirit. He or she will pray for you to receive the Holy Spirit. You will be glad you took this step of faith!
