Prophetic Declaration for 2018 by Ps Irene
during Watchnight Service, 31 December 2017

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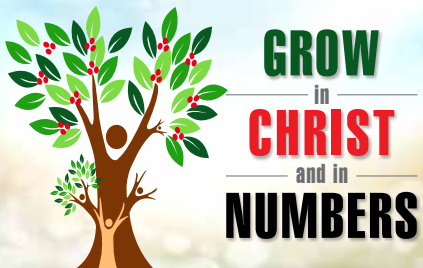

To gain wisdom and knowledge, I must revere and obey the Lord, study the Bible diligently and cultivate a close personal relationship with God. I must embrace knowledge, learn to discern the right people to be with and constantly watch and correct my behaviour and actions.”

- > To be accountable to those in our group in our daily devotion of prayer and Bible reading
