



DO YOU WANT A CHANGED LIFE?

In John 5:1-9, Jesus heals a cripple man at the pool named Bethesda in Jerusalem. When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, Jesus asked him, "Do you want to get well?" "Sir," he replied, "I have no one to help me get into the pool".

Jesus asked the cripple "Do you want to get well?". It was so obvious from the cripple's presence at the pool that he wanted to be healed. Why did Jesus ask this question? In order to understand Jesus' question, let us look at the cripple's background. The scriptures tells us that he had been in this condition for 38 years. He was used to receiving alms and sympathy and help from people. Others would get food and took him around. He didn't have to work. All the things were done by others for him.

The real intent of Jesus' question will then be "**Are you ready for your life to be changed?**". The cripple's life will be totally changed if he was healed. He have to learn new skills, develop new habits and do things completely different from his existing life. He has to learn to be independent and no longer depend on others for help. Does he want to be different?

Today, Jesus is still asking the same question of you and I. Do you want to be whole? Are you willing to forego the old in order to receive the new? Or do you want to continue in your disabilities, not physical ones but spiritual and emotional disabilities. The new life Jesus gives us requires that there should be progressive changes in our lives according to His word. Some want to be whole but also want to maintain their old life style. This type of attitude does not work in God's Kingdom. **Let us be the ones who want the new life and the promises of God and at the same time commit to take on the new aspects of our changed identity in Christ.**
